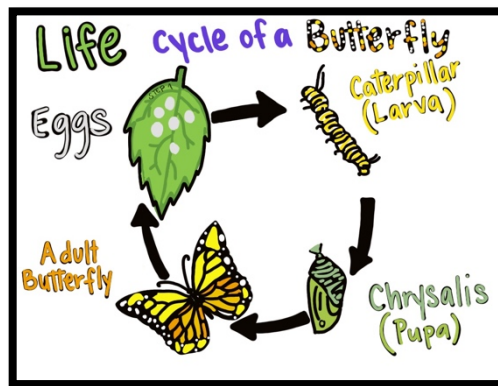
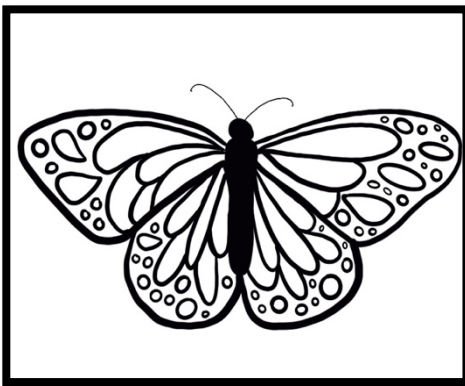
Bible Verse: Romans 6:20-23

- Crayons/markers/colored pencils

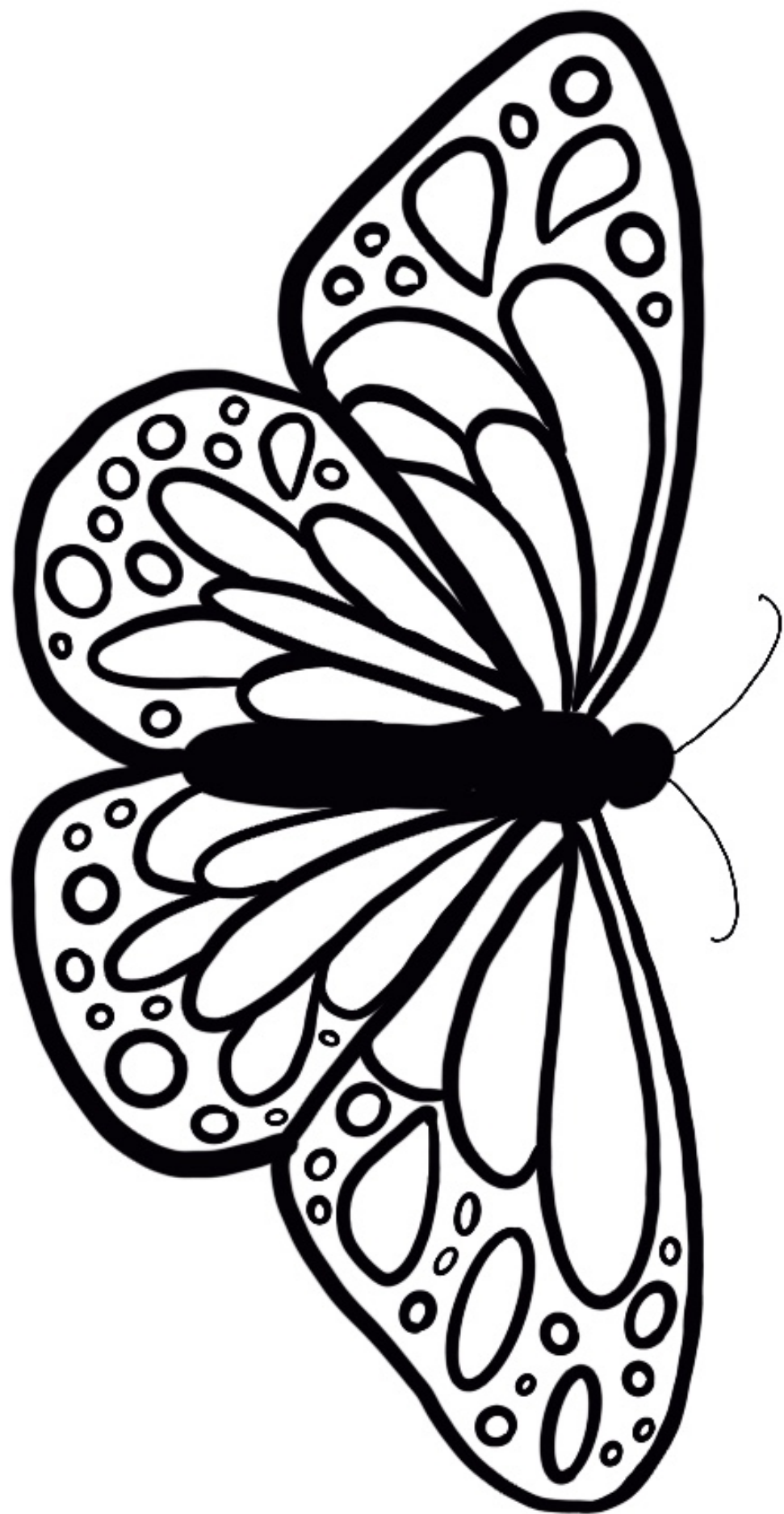
Activity:

Lesson:
