


**Apply Craft Tutorial – Keep Walking, August 22, 2020  
(Faith Sandal)**

Greetings, Friends! We continue making sandals which we are building upon to create footprints which represent walking with God. Here’s the third sandal for today, August 22.

- August 1: Walking in Truth (*completed*)
- August 8: Walking in Faithfulness
- August 15: Walking as God Commands
- August 22: Keep Walking**
- August 29: Walking in Integrity



**Materials:** Fun cardstock, foam, or cardboard, scissors, hole punch, scotch tape, markers, chenille stems (pipe cleaners), your favorite shoe or just your bare feet.

**Instructions:** Trace your own shoeprint or bare foot onto the fun cardstock paper or cardboard. Make three-hole punches in the areas recommended. Feed the chenille stem (pipe cleaner) through the holes to make the sandal strap. Tape down the stems so they won’t fall out. Feel free to make two sandals if you desire. Hang your sandal on your wall, refrigerator, or place somewhere in your room where you will be reminded to walk with God. Write ways that you know God is with you. Phrases like, God sees, God cares, God comforts, God is with Me.

**Teaching with the Craft:**

Knowing that God is with us no matter what in life helps us to stay faithful to Him with our thoughts and actions. It’s not always easy following God. There are people who are against God or don’t believe in Him at all. These people may make fun of us, mistreat us, or try to persuade us to give up on following God and follow something or someone else. The believers of Thessalonica were being mistreated for believing in God, so Paul wrote a letter to encourage them to stay faithful and not give up living their lives for God. Paul wanted them to remember that even though life on earth may be difficult for believers, they could hold onto the hope that someday, there wouldn’t be any more pain, suffering, or even death as they would be in heaven. These are great words to comfort one another with that help us endure hardship on earth. We should rely on the Holy Spirit to give us the endurance we need to make good choices and stay faithful to God. Knowing that God sees what we are going through, cares about us deeply and offers us comfort, helps us to Keep Walking with God.
