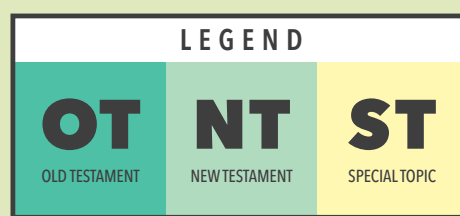

More than just a history lesson, this study contrasts the wise choices and foolish decisions by the leaders of the nation of Israel. As they evaluate the consequences of these leaders' actions, students are encouraged to follow their good examples, stand for what is right, and avoid their mistakes. Students can identify the universal challenges and temptations experienced by the kings of Israel and how they relate to the contemporary culture.
